PUBLISHED NOTICE OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT OF CLASS ACTION

**THIS NOTICE MAY AFFECT YOUR RIGHTS.
PLEASE READ CAREFULLY.**

FROM THE HONORABLE TOM R. SMITH, PRESIDING JUDGE, TO:

All Persons owning mineral interests that are or were burdened by oil and gas leases owned or operated in whole or in part by Anadarko Petroleum Corporation ("APC") covering property located in Kansas, and that were royalty owners of APC on production for any production month prior to January 1, 2009, to the extent that such production was sold by APC to any Affiliate of APC (including Anadarko Energy Services Company), but excluding (a) the United States of America to the extent that its mineral interests are managed by the Mineral Management Service (but such exclusion shall not exclude mineral interests that are owned by federally chartered corporations, including but not limited to the Farm Credit Bank of Wichita and the Federal Land Bank, which shall be included in the Settlement Class); (b) individuals or entities who own only (i) working interests under oil and gas leases, (ii) net profits interests, (iii) overriding royalty interests, or (iv) unleased mineral interests; and (c) APC and its Affiliates

The above-described persons are called the "Settlement Class."

A lawsuit was begun in 1993 and is pending in the District Court, Hugoton, KS, Case No. 98-CV-40, involving claims by Timothy J. Coulter ("Representative Plaintiff") against APC, as defendant. The Representative Plaintiff and APC have reached a proposed settlement in the lawsuit. The proposed settlement would inure to the benefit of and bind each member of the Settlement Class who does not elect to exclude himself or herself from the proposed settlement. The Court has scheduled a hearing on September 15, 2009, at 9:00 a.m. at the courthouse at 200 E. 6th Street in Hugoton, Kansas, to consider the certification of the Settlement Class, the approval of the proposed settlement, the payment of attorneys fees and expenses, the manner in which the proceeds from the proposed settlement should be allocated among the members of the Settlement Class, and certain other matters related to the proposed settlement.

A more comprehensive notice has been sent to those members of the Settlement Class whose addresses are known. If you fit within the definition of the Settlement Class but have not received a mailed notice, contact either of the following **immediately**,
